The Amorial Bearings of Sawbridgeworth Town Council give the town its identity and it is known as the 'town crest'. If you look closely at the crest, you will see oast houses that are symbols of the local malting industry, apple blossom in connection with the famous Rivers Orchard and between the two oast houses there is the Hertfordshire Hart. The motto at the bottom reads *Concordia Amicitia Coniuncta*, which roughly translated means 'Concord and Friendship Joined'. You can find an enlarged version of the crest on the reverse of this work sheet. There are lots of other things to spot in the crest too that are related to the town.
