



Replace existing lime trees to rear of boundary wall with new fastigate trees such as Upright Rowan, set back min. 3 meters from boundary wall.

Lower the wall height to approximately 1.2 meters to align with the lowest point on the eastern side of the wall to enhance visibility towards the garden.

Native fastigate trees that is proposed near the wall :

1. Sorbus aucuparia 'Autumn Spire' Upright Rowan

Ornamental medium sized trees such as:

1. Acer campestre Field Maple
2. Betula pendula var. carelica dwarf silver birch
3. Sorbus aucuparia Mountain Ash Rowan



Native hedgerow planting mix such as:

1. Corylus avellana - Hazel
2. Viburnum opulus - European Cranberry Bush
3. Ribes rubrum - Red Currant
4. Rosa rugosa - Rugosa Rose
5. Sambucus nigra - Elderberry
6. Malus sylvestris - Crab Apple



The species suggested here are for illustrative purposes only. A more comprehensive design plan will be developed subsequently. Any fruit trees included in this project should be cultivars specifically bred at the **Rivers Nursery in Sawbridgeworth.**
