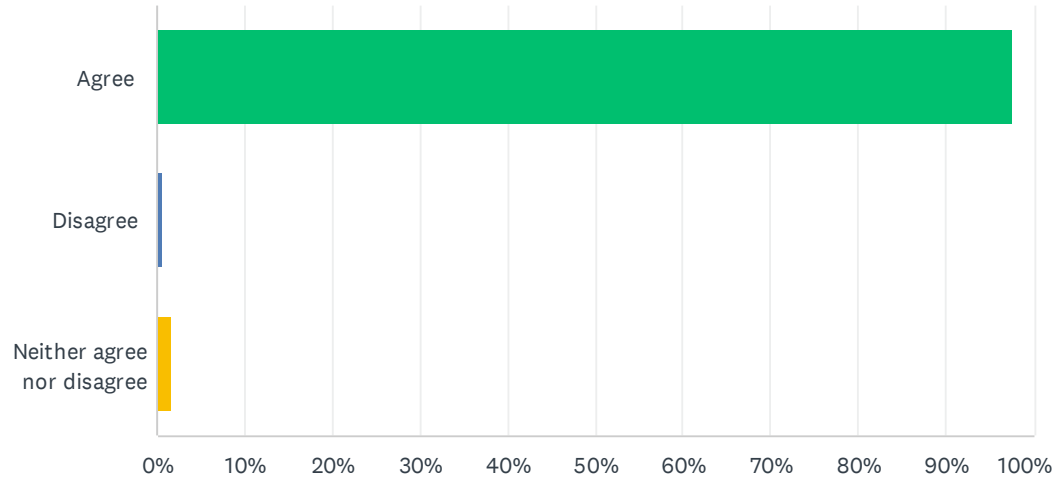


Q1 It is important to have an open green space in the town centre

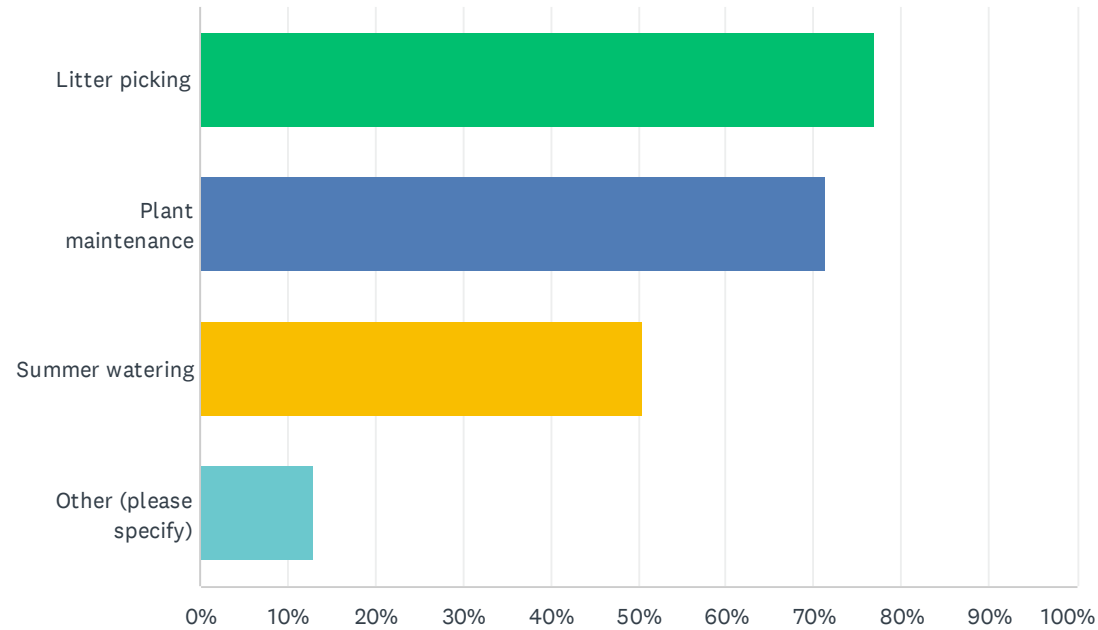

Q2 How can Sawbridgeworth Town Council help the residents get more involved in caring for this local green space? (tick all that apply)

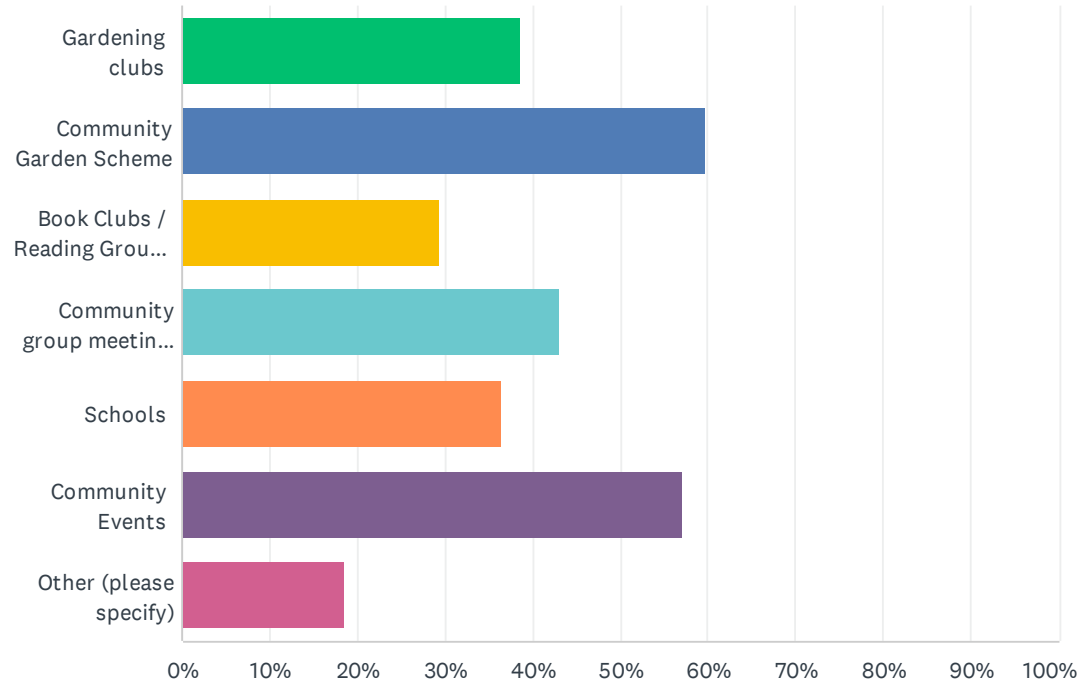

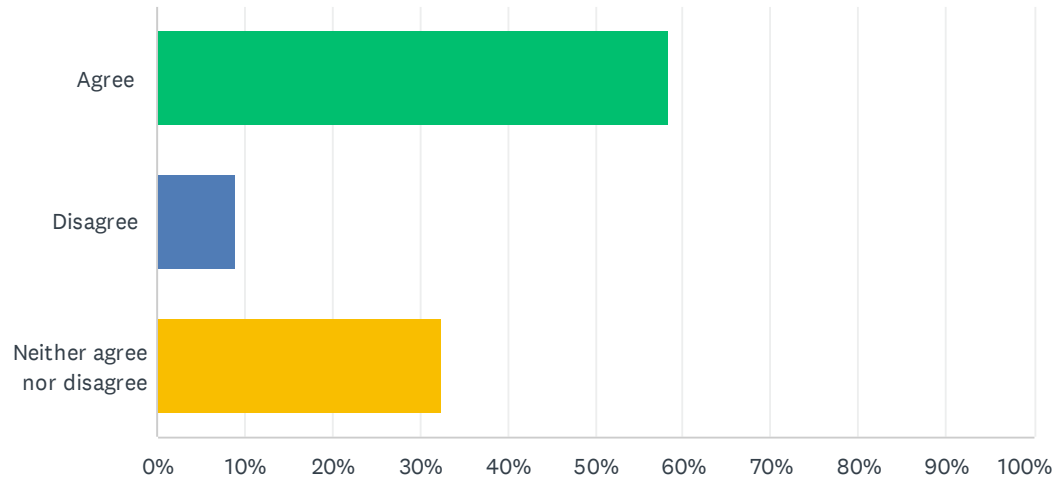

Q4 Historically this area was the garden of The Elms (adjacent white building, now Barley Barn Nursery) therefore the land should consider heritage assets.

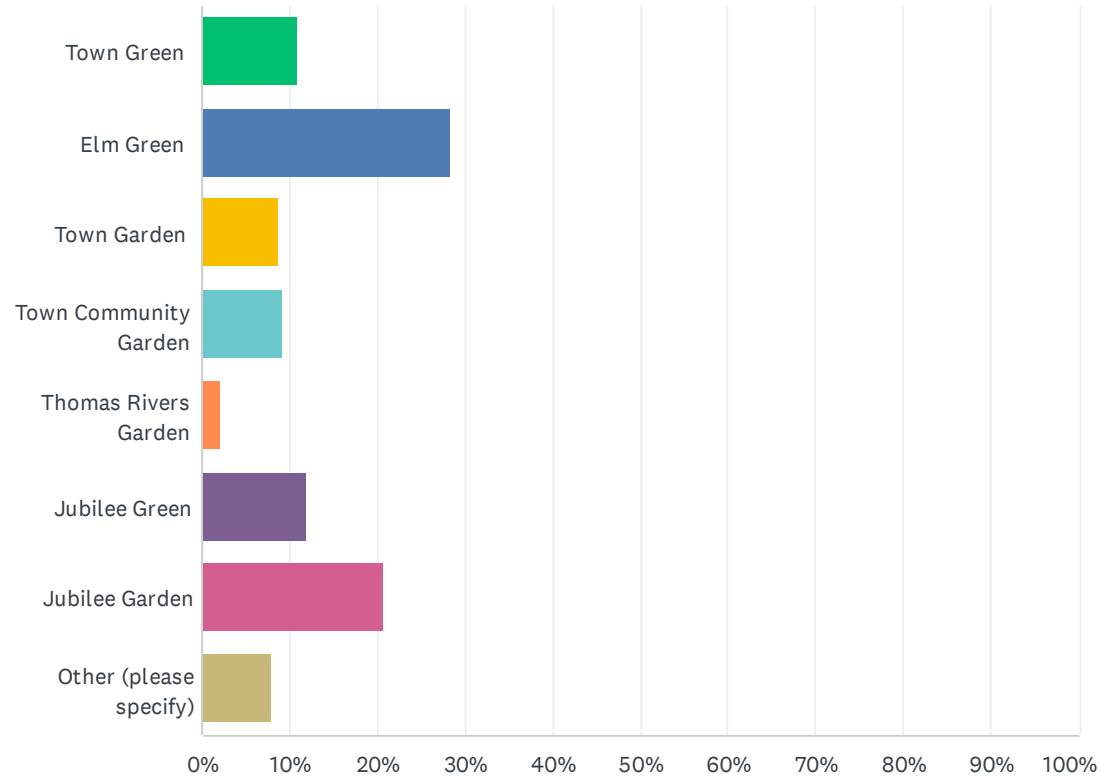

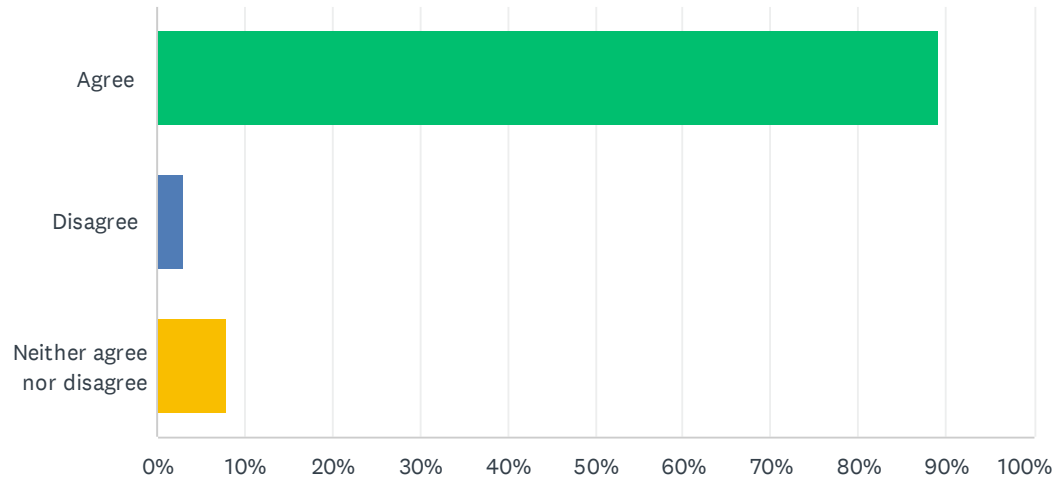

Q6 Do you consider improvements to the site must include visual attractiveness in terms of landscape, character and setting?

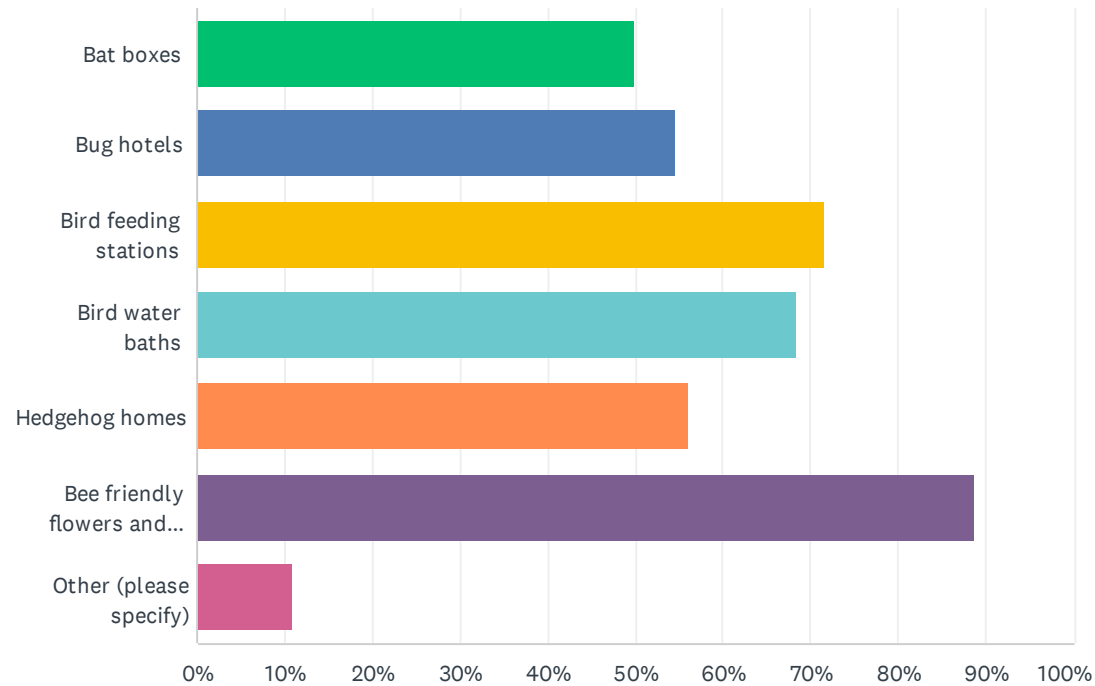

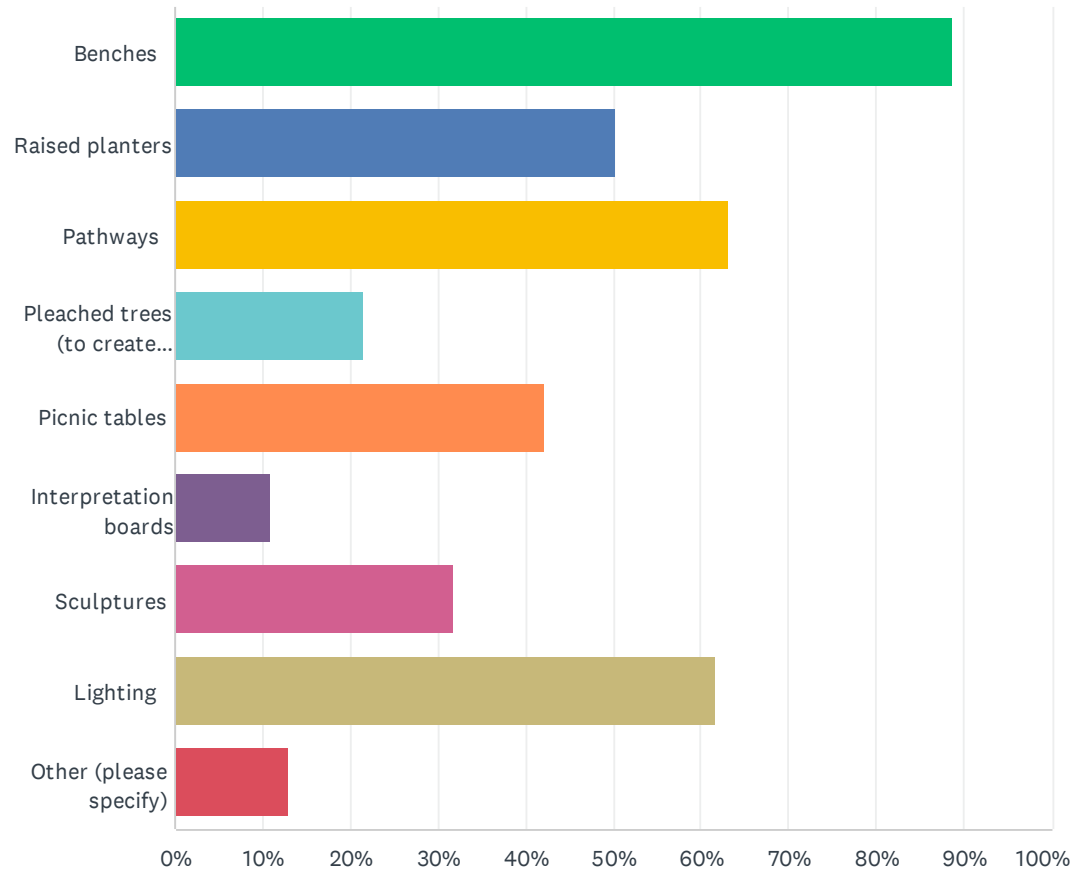

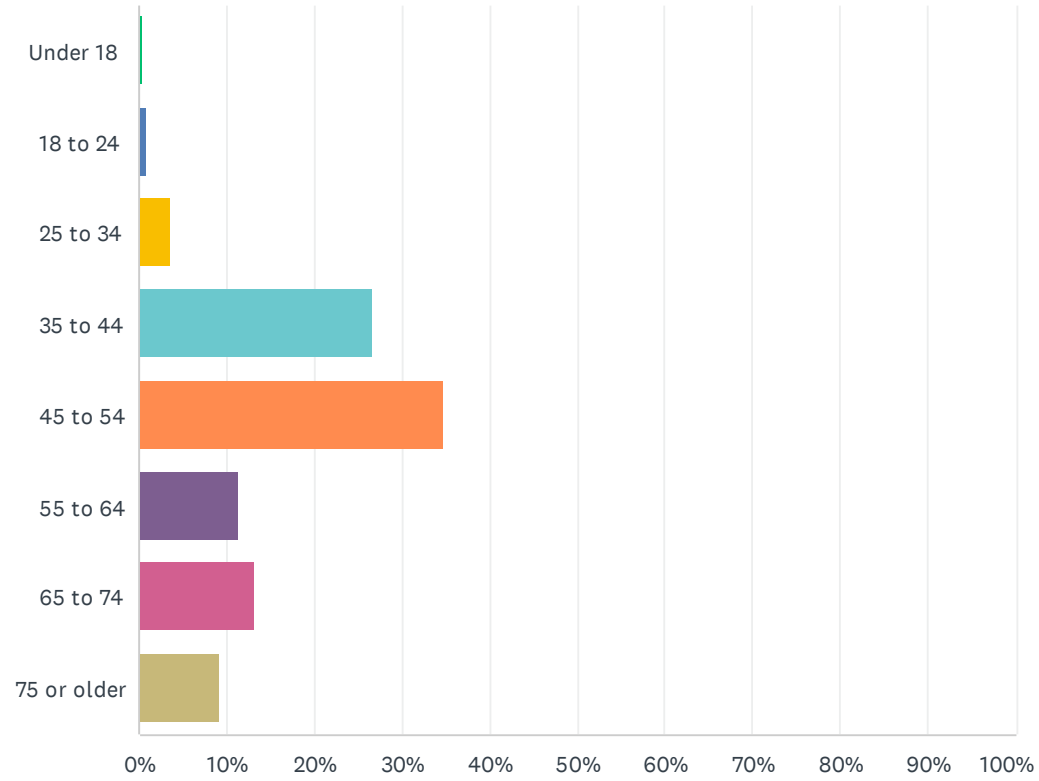
